**LOCATION:** All races at Steamboat Ski Resort on the All Out race trail

**ELIGIBILITY:** Open to all U16 & older RMD racers. Out-of-division entries must be approved by RMD prior to

registering.

ENTRY FEES: \$37 per day

ENTRY DEADLINE: Late fee of \$25 applies for all entries received after February 11, 2025.

ENTRY PROCEDURE: Enter and pay online https://www.skireg.com/colorado-sync-cup-u16-gs-qualifier-steamboat. Absolutely

no on-site entries, athlete must be paid and entered prior to Team Captains meeting.

**LIABILITY WAIVER:** All athletes must have completed two online waivers before race bibs will be issued.

IKON Pass and Base Passholders: Passes are valid on these dates, go straight to the lift.

Parents/siblings: 20% discount off window price, or \$79 Christie Peak only lift tickets (full access to the race hill). Full mountain tickets can be pre-ordered online using the link above, Christie Peak only tickets

must be purchased day-of in the ticket office.

**REGISTRATION:** No on-site registration. Team captains will pick up bibs by club at the <u>SSWSC Liman Mountain Center</u> in

the Torian Plum Plaza at the base of Steamboat Ski Resort.

or at Torian Plum/Ski Time Square Drive.

a 15 minute hike up from the base area.
