IKON Pass and Base Passholders: Passes are valid on these dates, go straight to the lift.

Parents/siblings: 20% discount off window price, or \$79 Christie Peak only lift tickets (full access to the race hill). Full mountain tickets can be pre-ordered online using the link above, Christie

Peak only tickets must be purchased day-of in the ticket office.

ENTRY PROCEDURE: Enter and pay online at https://www.skireg.com/age-class-open-slalom-steamboat. Late fee \$25

for entries after January 1. No on-site entries, athletes must be paid and entered prior to

Team Captains meeting.

LIABILITY RELEASE: All athletes must have completed online waivers for SSWSC and Steamboat Ski Resort before

race bibs will be issued. Complete liability waivers immediately after registering online.

BIB PICKUP: Coaches pick up bibs by team at the SSWSC Liman Mountain Center. No individual check-in.

LIFT: Christie Peak Express. Open at 8:30am for racers.

RUN ORDER: TRS seeding. U10, then U12, then U14. (U8's race with U10's in age class.)

AWARDS: Top 10 by age class (U10/U12/U14). At Gondola Square stage, 15 minutes after last racer.





SPECTATOR INFO: The course can be viewed from the See Me trail off the Christie Peak Express lift. Finish is about

a 15 minute hike up from the base area. See lift ticket section above for reduced-price ticket

information.

PARKING: Free parking in Knoll Lot (fills early) or Meadows Lot (shuttle to base area). Close-in pay

parking structure by Gondola Square. No parking or drop-off at Sheraton or Torian Plum.
